



EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP FOR MARES 2012

Sollalla, Sweden – August 15th

Group I – UET Masters Series – Autostart – 1.500.000 SEK

The European Championship for mares is open to 3 – 10 years old mares, with a record on 2.000 m or more of 1.13,9 or better, born or considered as born in the country they represent and registered in the Stud-Book of this country.

The participating horses will be nominated by the country they represent.

Each member country of U.E.T is entitled to participate with maximum three horses (except the organising country), being understood that each national Trotting Association shall indicate the preferential order of the horses they nominate.

The Championship will be held in one race with 12 horses maximum.

If the number of horses nominated as n° 1 is superior to 8 (eight), the horses starting in the first row will be selected according to their record over 2.000 m and more.

If less than 12 countries take part in the Championship, the field will be completed as follows:

First a second competitor of the organizing country, then a second competitor of every remaining member country. They will be selected on the basis of their record on 2.000 m or more and according to the places available. If after this procedure, the number of 12 horses is not reached, a third participant per country can be chosen by the same method.

If the maximum number of 12 horses is not reached, the field will be completed with horses from the organizing country.

The start positions will be assigned by public drawing.

Horse n° one (1) of each country starts in the first line according to the number of horses accepted in the first line in organizing country. (8 horses maximum)

The start positions from 1 to 8 will be drawn first.

The second horse of a member country can only start in the first line if all participating countries are already represented in this line.

The start positions of the second and third competitors will be drawn together.

Nominations and start declarations are free.

Entries: Monday, August 6th before 12h00 to Swedish Trotting

Start declaration: Thursday, August 9th before 8h30 to Swedish Trotting

The horses are not allowed to race anywhere after August 8th.
